Public Forum regarding agenda items only-Brian Murray Sr. asked if anything else was added to the agenda and Supervisor Smith said nothing added to the agenda.

Highway Report – Dale Root Highway Supt. gave a report of the past month. The Highway Dept. purchased a 6' finish mower for the John Deere compact as they continue to mow the fire halls, parks and water vaults. They also assisted in placing a headstone for past Councilman Ken Schaal. The stone came from Arlington. The north driveway has been closed off at the Mt Pleasant Cemetery due to people hitting headstones in that area. Non-potable signs have been placed on the spigots both in English and Spanish and water service within the cemetery has been repaired. The new mowing service contracted for mowing the cemeteries seems to be doing an exemplary job. E-waste is being stacked each morning. The Townline and Sanderson Road projects are completed. Shoulders were installed on Townline Rd. Martin Road Bridge has been removed and replaced. By September top coat should be able to complete the project. He thanked the County Highway Department for their help and support. With the continued support from the other towns and villages getting these projects done is a testimonial of shared services. He thanked The Towns of Ridgeway and Barre and the Village of Medina. On June 24, he submitted \$88,000 of Pave, NY, Extreme Winter and Chips re-imbursement forms, more

than half of what is due Shelby. He should be able to finish on next submittal date the money owed to the town. Dale has been negotiating with Hyundia about the three year buy-back program on the large loader. He thinks the proposal submitted is very favorable and would for approval. Dale has been talking to Ti-Sales about a new water meter reader. He will submit details of a proposal at the next meeting. He added his men have worked well accomplishing all of the projects. He thanked them and said all remain healthy despite COVID.

<u>Assessor Report</u>-Julie finished the first part of her two part classes, to be certified. She passed and in order to be certified you need to pass both parts. Second half will be on the web as past class. Trisha is taking continuing Ed class Thursday and Friday. Work is slow as it always is in the summer. Looking at completed Building Permits.

<u>Planning Board</u>-Tarpon Towers applied for Special Use Permit and Site plan review and area variance. The tower stands 165 feet. It will be placed on Creek Road. Public hearing is set for August 4 at 6:45 pm jointly with ZBA.

<u>Code Enforcement / Zoning Board Report</u> – (Dan Wolfe) – Working on building permits and inspections. Been working with Kirk regarding the Tarpon project.
