

## State of Emergency Declaration

A state of emergency is herewith declared within the jurisdiction of:

## Town of Shelby

Town of Shelby, NY for a period of time beginning at 3 pm on January 5, 2024 and will remain in effect for ninety (90) days or until rescinded by subsequent order.

The state of emergency has been declared due to the County of Orleans which the town of Shelby is a part of has had an increase of 178% in placement of homeless persons since July 2022, exceeding our limited number of temporary and permanent emergency housing facilities. The Town of Shelby does not have the capability to receive or sustain any number of migrants and/or asylum seekers.

Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being, and health of the citizens of this Municipality.

Additional local emergency order may be promulgated by the Supervisor Town of Shelby during this state of emergency in order to protect life and property and to bring the emergency condition under control.
