Pledge to the Flag

Purpose: To hear those for or against Revisions to Town of Shelby Zoning Law relating to Wind Energy Conversion Systems, Proposed Local Law 2

Mary Herbert is against the solar farms and wind turbines and changing the zoning codes. Mary thinks it is a great idea to not allow Large Industrial sized turbines

Barb Daluisio, What defines a Large sized turbine? Kathy answered that a large sized turbine would be anything over 120 ft.

Larry Waters wants to know why there is no height maximum. More verbiage needs to be used to dissuade companies from coming to town. These sections.....#597.5 Agricultural Exemptions and #597.1 Standards need to be addressed. The agricultural districts only need Special Variances and Special Use Permits.

Kathy Bennett explained that the changes came from the Planning Board and the Board will check with Kirk Myhill and the Planning Board for more input.

John Pratt explained that the Board need to do a SEQR Review which is where the Board must fill in the evidence then be involved with the SEQR

Kathy Bennett stated that the Board has taken on the lead position as SEQR. The SEQR needs to be approved. The Planning Board does the site approval and the Board as the lead agency gives the overall approval.

Ed Zelazny asked about wattage limits and what steps need to be taken if over the limit.

Kathy Bennett said approval through the State program OREZ would trump over Town approval.

Jim Heminway asked that the topic be tabled for this month so that the Attorney and residents can have time to review all the facts.

Kathy Bennett said everything in the noted is in the Town Zoning records already.

Ed Zelazny wants the information to be put on the Town website at least 1 week before the next meeting so that all residents can read it.
